CORONAVIRUS ISOLATION POLICY

These procedures have been put in place to protect the children, staff and community from the threat and spread of COVID-19

- If a child shows symptoms of Coronavirus, the member of staff caring for that child will immediately collect some resources and move with the child to the sensory room for isolation.
- The parent/carer will be contacted immediately and asked to collect the child.
- Once the child has been collected, the sensory room will be thoroughly cleaned by a member of staff wearing disposable gloves and apron.
 1. A disposable cloth will be used to clean all hard surfaces including windows and door handles with warm soapy water.
 2. These surfaces will then be disinfected.
 3. Disposable items used during the clean will be double bagged and stored in a marked lidded container by the outside bins for 72 hours before being disposed of in the general waste.
- If an area has been heavily contaminated, such as with visible bodily fluids, protection for the eyes, mouth and nose, will be worn as well as wearing gloves and an apron.
- If your child is sent home with symptoms you must follow the Government's Test and Trace procedures.

Children and siblings must not return to nursery for 14 days unless proof of a negative test result is produced.

Please make sure that you are always available by telephone during your child's session at nursery.

To keep you, your children and our staff safe we must all adhere to the Government's guidelines.
